General information

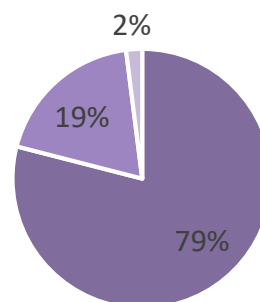
913 responses from **31** countries

7,5% of respondents, **6,3%** being carers, have been tested for COVID-19

⇒ **3%** tested positive.

1/4 responders did not have enough access to information about COVID-19 and CF.

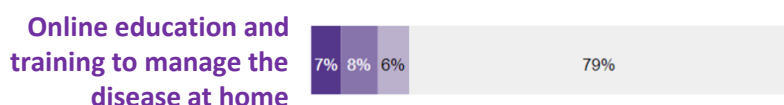
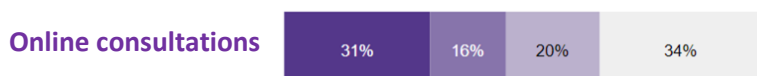

- Not available

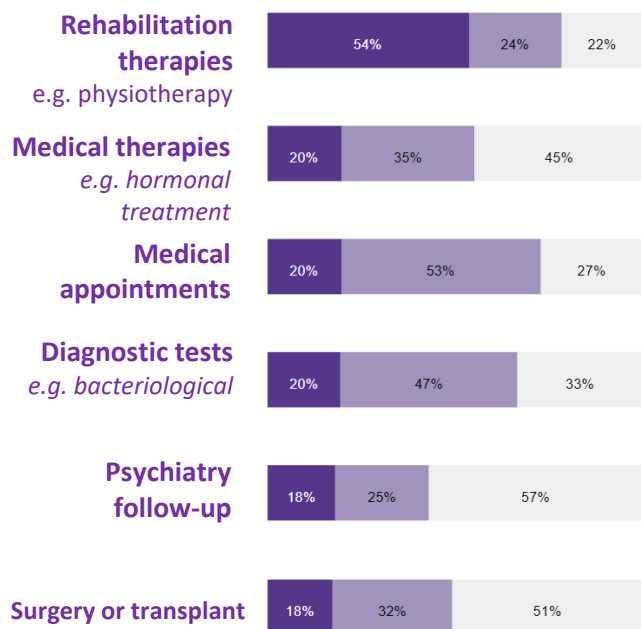


Types of “telemedicine” include email prescriptions, and online or phone consultations.

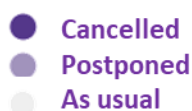
95% found these useful, but...

Only **1/4** had access to online training.

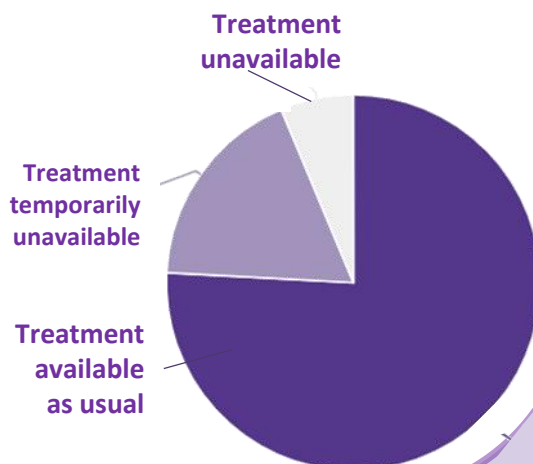
Treatment availability



Therapies, appointments, tests and surgeries were largely cancelled or postponed.



Treatments remained largely accessible, temporarily unavailable in **18%** of cases, unavailable in **6%** of cases.



Perspectives

56% carers and **36%** of patients feel a high level of threat.

85% fear that treatments may become unavailable.

2/3 think the situation has been detrimental to their well-being.
